I relinquish all rights that I may claim in relation to the use of said photographs.

INSURANCE INFO: All UW-River Falls camp participants are required to be covered by personal medical insurance. The UW System insurance provides primary insurance coverage with limited accident coverage of \$1,000 only.

HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNITY AND RELEASE: In consideration of permission for my child to voluntarily participate in the Falcon Basketball Camps, I agree to defend, hold harmless, indemnify, and release the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System, the University of Wisconsin-River Falls, and their officers, employees, agents, and volunteers, from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, or causes of action of any sort on account of damage to personal property, or personal injury, or death which may result from my/my child's participation in the above-listed program.
